GOLDEN DECISION bumped bit at the start, raced off the pace saving ground along inside, let out notch entering far turn then guided to far outside entering top stretch, set down for drive, kicked in determinedly and rallied along outside to get up in time. CHIEF WHITE SOX broke in and bumped bit at the start, held slim lead in first turn then dueled inside of TIDE OF THE DESERT through backstretch, held slim lead under pressure in far turn, dug in gamely and led the way past the furlong marker then got outkicked when rival kicked by late. ANDRONIKOS raced midpack saving ground through early stages, inched way up closer along rail at quarter pole, cut the corner turning for home then came out path and continued in contention racing two wide through lane. HONEY DONT stalked top two leaders through backstretch, patiently ridden through crowded quarters near quarter pole, roused three wide into stretch and continued with response. PAYNTER'S BOY raced off the pace, dropped to inside late far turn, angled out three wide, improved position then raced behind some traffic in final stages. AREYOUTALKINGTOME settled in early stages then advanced closer contention racing five wide at quarter pole, kept along four to five wide in stretch then finished evenly. AFFLUENTIAL unhurried, raced in the back then along inside in far turn, angled out upper stretch and failed

to kick on. SUM OVERTURE tugged bit wanting to do more in early stages while being rated, let out and advanced three wide near lead at quarter pole then failed to sustain bid entering stretch. TIDE OF THE DESERT dueled for the lead racing outside of CHIEF WHITE SOX through backstretch then quickly retreated in far turn.
