STAKES Ben Ali S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$6,000 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$1,000 to enter and an additional \$1,000 to start, with \$200,000 guaranteed, of which \$120,000 to the owner of the winner, \$40,000 to second, \$20,000 to third, \$10,000 to fourth, \$6,000 to fifth and \$4,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I stakes over a mile since November 2, allowed 3 lbs.; a Grade II stakes over a mile since October 5, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Ben Ali will be limited to fourteen. In the event that more than fourteen pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest earnings in 2018-2019. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Keeneland will present a trophy cup to the winning owner. Closed Wednesday, March 27, 2019 with 32 nominations.

Footnotes

BOURBON RESOLUTION stalked the pace early, made a bid three wide into the lane, swept past the leaders down the lane and drew off late under a steady drive. NUN THE LESS was unhurried early on, swung into the six path in the far turn, made a bid in the stretch but was no match for the winner in the final stages. THIRD DAY was bothered at the start, chased the pace early, shifted into the four path in the far turn, came in a bit nearing the sixteenth pole and moved up in the final stages. JUST WHISTLE came out at the start, chased the pace early, fanned into the five path in the far turn and improved position in the stretch run. SOLOMINI raced back early on from the inside, shifted into the three path entering the lane, altered back to the rail once in the stretch, lacked running room and altered out, was blocked behind a wall again, altered back to the rail and flattened out late in the drive. FLAMEAWAY was bothered at the start, set the pace early, shifted into the three path in the far turn, came out a bit down the lane while giving way. NOBLE COMMANDER tracked the pace early, shifted into the four path in the far turn while making a bid but was in tight in the stretch while tiring. HENCE was never a threat.

BONUS POINTS was never a factor. FIRST MONDAYS was done early.
