MIZZEN AIR set the pace early, fanned into the five path in the turn then drew away late in the stretch and was ridden out to the wire. ASHLEYS MAGENS BAY was unprepared at the start and trailed the field early on, fanned into the seven path in the turn and moved up in the stretch run. IRON LILLY tracked the pace early, swung into the six path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch drive. ABOUT THAT BASE was in tight early along the backstretch, steadied from between horses near the quarter pole, fanned into the five path entering the lane and faded late. FUNNY HOLIDAY was done early. PRINCESS LU LU was through after a half.
