Footnotes

FIRE MARSHAL had speed and led early, prompted the issue to the inside of BELMONTE leaving the five eighths, checked off that rival nearing the three furlong marker, shifted out and cruised up to rebid three wide after a half mile, secured command in upper stretch, kicked clear under some solid left handed asking in mid stretch then eagerly pulled away while steadily hand ridden the final sixteenth. PERFECT HEIR saved ground while not far back early on, gave up some ground leaving the far turn, eased out with some action past the five sixteenths, worked further out into the track past the furlong grounds and churned on to be second best. BELMONTE pulled his way to the front near the five eighths pole, set the pace in the two path, could not resist the winner soon into the lane, kept trying to about fifty yards out then faded. LIAR, three to four wide pursuing the pace, faded. DIAMOND NIC eased back off rivals early on, dropped in to save ground but failed to menace. L'OVERTURE, four to five wide while outside rivals, was under pressure mid turn and gave way. WATCHMENEIGHNEIGH gave early pursuit two to three wide, was steadied off heels nearing the three eighths pole and gave way. EAGLE CAVIAR broke sluggishly, raced four wide and failed to menace.
