**Footnotes**

DIRTYFOOT , in range four wide, was brushed and floated out when advancing into the lane, regrouped and moved to a slim lead leaving the furlong grounds, edged away slightly near the sixteenth pole then was fully extended to hold off THATWOULDBEGRAND. THATWOULDBEGRAND broke a step slow, angled out early, commenced a five wide run leaving the three eighths pole, raced about six wide into the lane and closed gamely. PADRINO'S HEART saved ground advancing to the half mile marker, tracked around the turn, slipped through along the rail and moved to near even terms for the lead in mid stretch but was out kicked in the final sixteenth. THREETHEHARDWAY was hard sent to the front, cleared early and set the pace two wide, drifted out brushing a rival entering the lane, fought on between runners in mid stretch then gave way grudgingly. MR SMURTHWAITE stalked three wide, bid outside the leader past the five sixteenths, was brushed and carried out a bit entering the stretch then faded in the final furlong. BAPTIZE THE BOY broke a bit slowly, edged up into tight quarters entering the far turn, steadied briefly, raced in range to mid turn then faltered.
