CASH EXCHANGE disputed the pace two wide around the turn, opened up in upper stretch and drifted out near the sixteenth pole despite right hand whipping. LINDA'S NEKIA , two wide turning for home, had a slight rally between horses. WALL lacked speed, swung to the four path leaving the turn, was fanned to the six path in mid stretch and had a mild rally outside rivals. RELENTLESS LION raced inside horses the final quarter pole, had aim on the lead in mid stretch and flattened out. AMERICA'S PRINCE saved ground stalking the duel around the turn, swung to the four path in upper stretch and gave way in the drive. GREAT COUNTRY circled the turn three wide and gave way after being fanned to the five path in upper stretch. EXPECT DRAMA disputed the pace, saved ground on the turn and faltered in mid stretch.
