Footnotes

BATTLE READY dueled to the inside of MAGICIAN'SCALENDAR through the opening five and a half furlongs, was roused clear of that one while off the rail in upper stretch, drifted out near mid stretch, was corrected and narrowly held. PATRIOT SAINT saved ground off the dueling leaders, angled out under pressure past the three eighths, moved up steadily leaving the three sixteenths, altered to the inside of the drifting winner near the sixteenth pole, made a game run but just missed. FRONT LINE PAIGE , three deep early on, shifted wider and circled five wide under a ride into the lane, straightened away but failed to kick on and faded. HOWYAFORMONEY was put in tight at the break, regrouped and edged up between foes, shifted in for the drive and had a minimal response. MAGICIAN'SCALENDAR came in at the break, corrected and dueled outside the winner, failed to go on with that one past the five sixteenths and faltered in the final quarter mile.
