SWITZERLAND took the lead at the rail at the five eighths pole and rated the pace, was pressured leaving the three eighths pole and dug in under steady encouragement to hold on well. LAKI rated close toward the inside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, gained little on the winner and had to settle for second best. SWEETONTHELADIES became edgy in the gate then saved ground off the pace, bid approaching the three eighths pole and was along for third inside the sixteenth pole. COLONEL SHARP stalked the pace off the rail, challenged the winner leaving the three eighths pole, held aim through the turn but dropped back into the stretch and flattened stride the final sixteenth. LEWISFIELD rated close, rounded the turn in the six and seven paths, entered the stretch widest and finished evenly. THE MAN stalked the pace toward mid track, bid into the turn, left the turn in the six path and had little left. ARTHUR'S HOPE was not a factor. ALWAYS SUNSHINE rated close to the early pace toward the outside, rounded the turn about the five path then angled in at the top of the lane and weakened.
