COLONY CLASSIC secured good position to the far turn, made a good inside run to the lead in the stretch but drifted out under left handed urging in the final sixteenth impeding horse on the outside late. SOLAR MAXIMUS far back to the half, asked for run, rallied outside with a late run in deep stretch but was impeded late and could not get past the leader. DAMAGE CONTROL sent hard from outside, set pace to the stretch but faltered late. DONTBOTHERMENOW went to rail backstretch while far back, floated outside into stretch and moved up while no threat. TAPIDOR unhurried early, asked for run at the half with a mild response but faltered in the stretch. MAGIC APPLE pressed the pace to the half but began to weaken and dropped back. HANDY CANDY good position early on, no late rally on the turn and stopped. AFTER A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN, COLONY CLASSIC WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED SECOND FOR IMPEDING THE PROGRESS OF SOLAR MAXIMUS IN THE FINAL SIXTEENTH.
