WAR BALLAD trailed from the gate, circled horses steadily in the five path on the turn and into the stretch, made the lead before the furlong marker and drew off under brisk handling. DEVILISH MAGIC dueled for the lead three then two wide into the stretch and finished second best. WICKED KISSER stalked the pace into the turn, was in a bit tight nearing the top of the stretch and finished with good courage. WAKEETA dueled for the lead along the inside into the turn, drifted out entering the top of the stretch then gradually weakened. LOVE YAMARI failed to menace. PUBLIC MERGER battled for the lead between horses two wide into the stretch and weakened late. LA COYOTA was through after a half. CROSSING ALASKA was through early. HOT VALENTINA showed little. THE RIDER OF WICKED KISSER LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF THE WINNER FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE NEAR THE QUARTER POLE, AFTER REVIEW THE STEWARDS UPHELD THE ORIGINAL ORDER OF FINISH. DUE TO A TIMER MALFUNCTION THE FRACTIONAL TIMES WERE UNAVAILABLE. FINAL TIME WAS HAND TIMED.
