PERFECT EXECUTION sprinted clear at once, raced three-wide while setting the pace, was well rated through the back-stretch, increased his margin into the stretch and was ridden out to the wire. WELLINGTON WIZARD lacked early speed, saved ground through the second turn, remained inside for the drive and finished willingly. MATADOR was reserved just off the leaders early, moved three-wide through the second turn and failed to gain in the drive. NOBLE KENT settled off the leaders early, moved five-wide through the second turn and finished evenly. PROSPECTOR ALLEY broke sharply to chase the winner while racing four-wide and weakened after going five furlongs. SNOOP was off slow, lacked early foot, raced four-wide through the second turn and was not a factor. TH ORIGINAL SCOTTY raced far back throughout.
