BLAZING D. R. sprinted clear at once, raced three-wide while setting the pace, was well rated through the back-stretch and was ridden out through the lane while being kept to task. GIRLIE'S DREAM was reserved just off the leaders early, raced four-wide through the second turn, was no match for the winner in the drive but clearly second best. ROMAN TIMES raced unhurried early, saved ground through the second turn, angled out in mid-stretch and finished evenly. ZIGGY IS ZUBBY chased the leaders while racing three-wide and weakened after going three-quarters. LADY IN PURSUIT lacked early foot, raced four-wide through the second turn and was not a factor. JABURU stumbled at the start and unseated her rider.
