DANCE REHEARSAL sprinted clear at once, raced three-wide while setting the pace, was well rated through the back-stretch and held sway to the wire. BLEU MOON TYPHOON was reserved just off the leaders early, advanced five-wide through the second turn and finished with a steady bid. ALWAYS SUMMER (GB) showed no early speed, raced four-wide through the second turn and finished with some late run. HERE'S WATTEVER was forwardly placed throughout from off the rail and lacked the needed closing response. HONEYDUKES raced four-wide through the first turn, settled off the leaders early, moved five-wide through the second turn and failed to rally. FLASHY SIREN was void of early speed, raced off the rail through the second turn and did not reach contention. FUEGO MI AMOR chased the leaders while racing four-wide and weakened after going a half.
