I CRIED A TEAR dueled between foes and then was left with the rail on the turn, resisted gamely when challenged and held on. POINT LOCKOUT saved ground throughout and finished with good energy. FIRE COMMAND broke slowly, raced just off the rail, split rivals near quarter pole and closed well. GRAND BLUE HARBOR dueled inside, fell back slightly after a quarter mile, angled out three wide near quarter pole and finished gamely. PRINCESS RASHELLE ducked out leaving the gate, dueled for command three then two wide and held on well. HIGH MATH also ducked out leaving the gate, raced wide and failed to menace. TIMELY PLEASURE showed nothing. YES IT'S DYNA, wide and just off the pace, tired. STREET APPEAL broke slowly, was hustled up in the three path then faltered through the stretch.
