FORMER EMPIRE earned a narrow advantage outside, vied through the turn, continued well but was no match for the winner. PREP PRIDE steadied briefly in the opening quarter, saved ground and flattened out. NEW ROAD prompted the pace three wide to midway on the turn and faltered. SPRING TUNE dropped back early and was never in contention. SHIMERVILLE hustled to the front inside, dueled for five furlongs then bore out tiring in the stretch. ALEX'S FAST LANE hesitated and lunged at the start then was outrun and lost contact with his field.

POSTINO'S CHAMPION steadied briefly in tight in the opening furlong, waited for room on the turn, swung wide into the stretch, was forced out wider by drifting out rival mid stretch, took the lead and edged away. TIZ ALL BEHIND US, in the four path while unhurried, eased out and then in and split rivals rallying and was gaining. JEANJEANNIE, two wide early and then was left with the rail, split rivals on the turn and lacked a strong closing kick. HELLO MOON, very wide in second flight, took the lead leaving the turn, was clear in mid stretch but then weakened. ELIJAH'S PARTY broke slowly, raced wide and rallied too late. MY AUNT LILLY ducked out at the start, was very wide while just off the pace, ducked out again when roused left handed mid stretch then faltered. STREET CHARM, in the three path and not far back, swung out entering stretch but lacked a strong closing kick. LADY BREVET set the pace in the three path and faded through the final furlong. FAIR LADY SADIE broke slowly, was hustled up along the rail then stopped. SOPHIA'S HEART bore out badly leaving the turn and dropped far back.

PRETTY COOL CAT hustled to the front inside, lost the advantage near the far turn and faded. SO GOOD TO GO trailed for five furlongs then passed fading rivals. ROYAL DEL MAR broke slowly, chased wide and weakened on the final turn. EMPRESS CARO raced just off the pace inside and stopped abruptly.
