NORTHERN TRAIL pressed the pace while being well handled, rallied in upper stretch and was in a long drive and drew away in the end. SAVED BY ZERO was well placed while three wide into the turn, was in a strong drive in the stretch and was second best in the end. THERMISTOR vied for the lead from the inside, was in a long hard drive but weakened in late stretch. WHITE WALLS chased the early pace while four wide into the turn, made a bid in upper stretch then was no menace in late stretch. JUSTAS LOUD was saving ground on the turn then raced inside in the stretch but failed to menace in the end. OKLAHOMA Z was very fractious in the gate then was unhurried early and no threat. STERLING APPEAL was unhurried early and no factor. MIDNIGHT LINGER was inside on the turn and no threat.
