FOR THREE YEAR OLDS WHICH HAVE NOT WON A GRADED SWEEPSTAKES OVER A MILE IN 2018. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 124 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstake at a mile or over in 2018 allowed 2 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance races at a mile or over in 2018 allowed 4 lbs.; of such a race in 2018 allowed 6 lbs. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, July 14, 2018 with 27 Nominations.

HOFBURG bumped at the start by MADISON'S LUNA who broke in a step, raced three to four wide through the opening bend at the tail of the field before taking to the five path down the backstretch, got within closer aim as the leader came under rating to slow the pace, remained on hold until NICODEMUS came under urging into the far turn and came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths in response, stacked outside the top pair three furlongs out in remaining in the five path and displacing the leader in tandem with NICODEMUS through the latter portion of the bend, swung three then two wide into upper stretch having seized command at the quarter pole, edged clear under a drive until nearing the sixteenth marker, came under hand urging solely at that station before being geared down in the late stages. NICODEMUS bumped shortly after the start by ZING ZANG, raced two to three wide through the first turn before settling three wide in close aim of the leader down the backstretch as the pace slowed six furlongs out, remained patiently handled until HOFBURG began to advance outside, came under urging just past the half mile pole, advancing to apply pressure to the leader AMERICAN LINCOLN with seven-sixteenths to run, stacked between foes in the four path three furlongs from home, took over command near the five-sixteenths, got overtaken by HOFBURG just outside the quarter pole, spun just off the inside for home, attempted to tip out three-sixteenths out, then ran on to chase the winner home no match for that rival through the final eighth while well clear of the rest. ZING ZANG hustled from the gate, bumped with NICODEMUS shortly after the start, tracked the pace along the inside ranging up to close range as the pace slowed six furlongs from home, tipped out to the three path put to urging at the half mile pole as the top trio began to slip away, swung four wide into upper stretch having passed tired rivals and weakened in the late stages while along for the show honors. AMERICAN LINCOLN coaxed from the gate, established the front crossing to the three then two path into the first turn, spurred away briefly into the backstretch before coming under rating and slowing the pace down which in turn allowed the rest of the field to advance into close aim, remained on hold until put to a drive at the seven-sixteenths attempting to slip away from the top two, got collared three wide nearing the five-sixteenths, cornered two to three wide for home and was not persevered with through to the finish. MADISON'S LUNA broke in at the start bumping HOFBURG, raced forwardly placed inside through the first turn before chasing three wide in aim down the backstretch, came under coaxing half a mile from home, got shaken off and backed away through the turn, went three to four wide for home and faltered.
