FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$600 each which should accompany the nomination; \$4,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$4,500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$6,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade One at a mile or over in 2018 allowed 2 lbs.; of a Grade Two at a mile or over in 2018 allowed 4 lbs.; of a Grade Three at a mile or over lifetime allowed 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, July 14, 2018 with 25 Nominations.

Footnotes

TENFOLD was hustled from the start, raced in the two path on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, turned up the pressure on the leader in the two to three path on the far turn, took the lead inside the three-sixteenths, began to drift out under a left-handed whip approaching the furlong marker, switched to a right-handed whip shortly thereafter, ducked out when given a second crack of the whip in the vicinity of the sixteenth-pole, bore out under a continued right-handed whip to the wire and proved best while outside the middle of the track. FLAMEAWAY went to the front, set the pace on the inside through solid fractions while being dogged by the winner, was asked near the seven-sixteenths, vied inside under urging on the far turn, turned into the stretch under a left-handed whip, lost the advantage inside the three-sixteenths, kept on well in the final furlong, switched to a right-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and missed while just able to get the place. VINO ROSSO was asked leaving the gate but lacked early speed, moved in at the rear of the field, saved ground on the first turn, was urged along on the backstretch, rounded the far turn under stronger encouragement, gained under a left-handed whip in upper stretch and closed strongly to just miss the place while clear for the show. RERIDE hit the inside of the gate at the start but came out with the field, went three wide on the first turn, settled in third position, was asked in the three to four path on the far turn, pursued the leaders under a drive, drifted out nearing the furlong marker, continued to drift out some until near the sixteenth-pole and was out-kicked. SPORTING CHANCE went around the first turn in the four path, settled last but one, was urged along in the three path early on the far turn, swerved out when the rider let go of the left rein to change goggles at the three-eighths then dropped back abruptly, swerved further out near the quarter-pole and was pulled up but walked off.
