Footnotes

KATE IS A TEN took up position in the two path after the break, attended the pacesetter being reserved, fell back a bit, nearly becoming unhitched, as the third fraction was being finalized, got called upon a sixteenth later, was floated approximately six wide into the stretch, trudged her way to the front, then steadily extended the winning marging. PERINA'S PRIDE remained along the rail after the field had been sent off and running, continued to take it to the end of the far turn, was roused angling three wide into the stretch, drifted out several additional paths in the final seventy yards rallying for the place. LA INESPERADA away the fastest, retained the advantage, glided over to the inside route early on the clubhouse bend, showed the way, coaxed and with eventual winner in accompaniment out in path two, edged away to her largest lead as three-quarters was being completed, came under assault from a revved-up LA INESPERADA coming to the top of the lane, sputtered five wide into the lane when set down, taking the aforementioned foe along for the ride, had already surrendered when checked and corrected at the eighth pole, tired enough in the final stages to lose out on second too. MIDNIGHT BOUNTY had the pilot grab hold at the start, raced three wide around both turns, fanned out into path six from upper to midstretch and was outfinished. SHAKESPERIAN DREAM towards the three path on the first turn, was slightly closer to the rail on the subsequent one, went about it put to encouragement, came into the stretch and lacked the needed response. SWEETNEIDA in the two path between rivals early, stayed there taking up the chase after leaving the backstretch, lost the rider after taking bad steps coming to the eighth pole, then was vanned off.
