D'FUNNYTHING chased the pace from third, made a bid between horses at the seven-sixteenths, vied three then two wide on the turn, was asked once straightened for the drive, came under a right-handed whip while dueling with the runner-up into the final furlong, fought with that foe until near the sixteenth-pole and proved best under strong urging. GAMING came away in good order, contested the pace on the inside of BOOKMAN, vied along the rail on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths, dueled with the winner under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and missed while able to hold the place. TERRY O GERI brushed the outside of the gate at the start, settled under some urging, went two to three wide while under a strong hand ride on the turn, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, pursued the top two into the final sixteenth and was out-kicked while clear for the show. BENEVOLENCE was urged along at the rear of the field, raced inside early on the turn, angled three wide just inside the five-sixteenths, swung five wide into the stretch, came under a right-handed whip on the outside, switched to a left-handed whip inside the furlong marker and lacked the needed response. CERRETALTO was a bit reluctant to load, settled off the pace, was urged along passing the half-mile pole, chased three wide on the turn, spun four wide into the stretch, dropped back under the whip and faltered. BOOKMAN contested the pace on the outside, vied in the two path early on the turn, dropped back under at the three-eighths then moved to the rail and stopped.
