STAKES Sunland Park Derby Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. Weights; Colts-Geldings 122 lbs. Fillies 117 lbs. Certain finishing positions in this race will earn points to qualify for the 2019 Kentucky Derby, pursuant to the official rules for The Road To the Kentucky Derby published by Churchill Downs Incorporated. The winner of The Sunland Park Derby will be awarded 50 points, the second place finisher 20 points, the third place finisher 10 points and the fourth place finisher 5 points. First preference: lifetime earnings in graded stakes, second preference, highest lifetime earnings. Horses excluded at time of entry to receive a full refund of all payments. This race will be limited to twelve starters. After payment of 1% to all owners finishing sixth through last, The remaining purse will be distributed as follows, 60% to the winner, 22% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth.

Footnotes

CUTTING HUMOR well-positioned stalking just off the leaders in the four path into and on the first turn, continued to track outside ANOTHERWISTAFATE off the leading pair up the backstretch, took closer order three wide into the far turn, took a narrow lead at the top of the stretch, edged just clear in mid-stretch then held under steady urging to set a new track record. ANOTHERWISTAFATE between rivals at the fore heading into and on the first turn, eased back off rivals to track in behind under cover, forced to wait just briefly nearing the quarter pole as first CUTTING HUMOR then WICKED INDEED moved past outside him then came out four wide for room following the former and inside the latter leaving that bend, took aim on the leader and gained steadily but slowly and just missed. MUCHO GUSTO led rivals narrowly into the first turn along the rail, was further pressured by HUSTLE UP heading up the backstretch through swift early fractions, thereupon joined by the winner leaving that bend as HUSTLE UP began to weaken, matched strides briefly then weakened through the final furlong. WICKED INDEED tucked in behind the leading trio heading into the first turn content to track off the leaders, was asked for a little more run about the half-mile marker, shifted out gradually late on the far turn coming four wide past the quarter pole and looming a threat, came into upper stretch five deep then flattened out. EYE CLOUD settled at the rear racing off the inside, began to pick it up swinging six wide into the stretch and improved position. PASAMONTE MAN shifted in early racing in behind not too far off the leaders, continued near the inside and failed to rally. HUSTLE UP caught three wide through the first turn keen to be amongst the leaders, kept in the three path up the backstretch then shifted in a bit to apply

more pressure to MUCHO GUSTO, began to weaken leaving the far turn and shifted in, faded in the stretch. COLLUSIONIST raced near the inside and failed to threaten. WALKER STALKER forced five wide through the first turn and in range, continued off the inside and just back off the leaders up the backstretch, encouraged along three to four wide past the three-eighths pole but emptied out in the stretch.
