TOO CHARMING tracked along the inside, bid two wide on the far turn, responded when asked, kicked clear in midstretch and held well under urging. LEMON PRINCESS was bumped at the start, raced off the pace inside, advanced on the far turn, came three wide into the lane and rallied well to earn the place spot. FULL TILT TREASURE vied inside for the early lead, shook free on the backside, dueled into the stretch and dug in along the rail to earn the show award. OSARE was bumped at the start, outrun early while saving ground, advanced inside on the far turn, came two wide into the lane and rallied mildly. RENEWED ENERGY raced off the pace outside a rival, moved up inside on the far turn, then failed to threaten. STORMY ARABELLA stumbled badly and was bumped at the start, then stalked two wide and tired. QUEEN DIVA vied two wide early, then chased two wide and faded.
