Footnotes

BROOKLYN SPEIGHTS stalked the pace, launched his bid three deep, took over inside the furlong marker and edged clear. BRO STROLL was unhurried, wheeled out leaving the second turn, quickened and was gaining with every stride. PRIMED FOR TALENT stalked the pace, forged command leaving the second turn, contested the issue to the final furlong and flattened. THE BUCKEY KID settled in hand, moved up five wide to make a mild bid, but failed to sustain the drive. PASS SET HIT sped clear and angled in to set the pace, was headed leaving the second turn, disputed the issue to the furlong marker and weakened. SUCCESS PHIL was allowed to settle, and lacked a response when called upon. INNOCUOUS showed little. PURE POWER stopped after a half and was distanced through the stretch.
