Footnotes

BEACH PATROL pushed the pace on the outside, went around the first turn in the three path then was able to get into the two path turning for home, responded to the challenge from DEAUVILLE (IRE) through the lane and dug in gamely to edge clear of that foe at the sixteenth pole then held off a late running FANCIFUL ANGEL (IRE). FANCIFUL ANGEL (IRE) broke in a tangle then recovered to track the pace on the inside, stayed on the rail through both turns then had a bold rally when asked for more and got up in time for place. DEAUVILLE (IRE) bobbled at the start then got in tight as he came into stride, chased the pace on the inside taking both turns while on the rail, rallied very well when asked for more taking a brief lead at the eighth pole but was caught. ENTERPRISING stuttered a bit coming out of the gate but got into stride quickly, sat well rated off the pace while on the rail, began to rally when asked for more but was faced with tight quarters, got the space he wanted with about a sixteenth to go and gained from there. ASCEND bobbled at the start then trailed the field while running in the two path, maintained his position into the stretch then ran gamely between horses. OAK BROOK exploded out of the gate then was eager to take the lead, went around the first turn in the two path then got in towards the rail on the backstretch, kept the momentum going down the stretch digging in when asked for more then was outfinished by the closers. DIVISIDERO went two wide around the first turn while running towards the rear, stayed at the back through the backstretch then swooped into the seven path at the top of the stretch where he uncoiled a long outside

rally. OSCAR NOMINATED broke outward then got up to chase the pace between horses, went two wide around the turns but was forced to swing into the four path at the top of the stretch looking for running room then finished evenly from there. KASAKUI (ARG) sat well rated off the pace while going two wide around the turns, began to quicken his pace then was forced to swing into the five path at the top of the stretch where he had a mild rally. MEKHTAAL (GB) sat well rated off the pace while going two wide around both turns, swung into the five path at top of the stretch but he lacked the needed rally. GHOST HUNTER chased the pace on the outside going three wide around the turns, vied for the lead at the three eighths pole then retreated. THE PIZZA MAN tracked the pace on the outside taking the first turn three wide, moved up closer to the pace at the three quarters pole then held his position into the turn, went four wide then was forced to go into the six path at the top of the stretch and had no rally.
