

SPRING QUALITY was rated along stalking the the pacesetter from the two path, continued under the same set up all the way to the quarter pole, was given his cue challenging in earnest stepping into the stretch for the final time, however, from path three, out-fought a pair of opponents to the inside to appear to poke a head in front by the eighth pole, vied with vigour past that station, eventually managing to edge away in the final seventy yards. CALL PROVISION unhurried in the two path, sprang to life late on turn three, got spotted three wide leaving that final bend, responded when asked, splitting rivals both in midstretch and deep stretch with good energy en route to nailing down the place. GET JETS put to a snug hold of the starting gate, put up a brief fight before yielding to the pilot and getting taken back, slipped off the inside leaving the second bend, was angled three wide on the turn three, one of several maneuvering to the outside on the that bend, moved out a couple of additional paths down the lane rallying for the show. MONEY MULTIPLIER kept watch on the leader loosely pocketed during the initial stages, closed the gap leaving the backstretch the second time, arrived at the head of the stretch with enough room along the inside corridor to launch a rally of his own, was called upon and attempted to do so, fought as the innermost of three down the lane, flattened out late and had to settle for the final significant slice of the pot. MEMORIES OF PETER quickly established control, sailed along from the rail on an open lead, laying down fractions on the soft side, came under some pressure for the first time after entering the final bend, shifted into the two path when put to a drive at the head of the stretch, surrendered by the barest of margins in midlane, battled between rivlas the remainder of the trip home, weakening late. MESSI (GER) took up the chase from the two path, waited behind opponents coming to the quarter pole, was clear enough to get asked to rally a sixteenth later, failed to fire appreciably. SOLUBLE (GER) off the inside, was strung out four wide on the last bend, failed to menace. OSCAR NOMINATED along the inside during the initial stages, was eased into the two path midway on the backstretch the second time, was one path wider heading off it, angled

still wider for the drive home, had no offering. HUNTER O'RILEY saved ground, got sent out into path four on the third turn, never made it presence felt. TRICKED UP reserved in the two path, was driven six wide into the stretch to no avail.
