**Footnotes**

BLACKTYPE (FR) came away to an alert beginning, prompted HELLO DON JULIO from the outside, saw the pilot take back soon after stepping the backstretch, had room along the inside to tip into and did so, gaining the benefit of drafting behind the aforementioned rival for much of the journey to the half mile pole, tipped back into path two at that station, narrowed in, turned for home directly abreast of the pacesetter, got turned loose a few strides later, responded eagerly to arrive at the eighth pole as the new leader, dug in with good determination to fend off the late challenger. MUQTASER sat reserved in midpack taking the two path, got asked for more heading for home and did indeed pick it up, was lightly steadied altering course into path four in midstretch, kicked into his best after completing the maneuver, finished with good energy but got staved off by an opponent likewise in possession of good energy. HELLO DON JULIO put to some hand encouragemet for the first jumps out of the starting gate, worked its way to a narrow advantage by the end of the homestretch, cut the pace being shadowed by the eventual winner, with that foe mostly going about at the task from the two path, saw BLACKTYPE draw up in a menacing manner, relinquished by upper stretch, continued onward in a willing manner to secure the show. SPRING QUALITY strung out three wide on boths, fanned out into path six from upper to midstretch, flashed a mild late response to nail down the last major check. CAMELOT KITTEN made it over to the rail well before the crown of the clubhouse bend, middle-moved his way into a better position on the backstretch, got cued up angling three wide into the lane, flattened out in the last eighth. SMOOTH DADDY pinched stepping onto the first turn, went on to save ground to no avail. FORGE (GB) forwardly placed three wide, gave way. SIR DUDLEY DIGGES unhurried in the two path early, moved out into path three at the five-sixteenths pole, swung a couple of paths wider for the stretch, made no impact. THE GREY GATSBY (IRE) took up the chase from the two path, was urged three wide into the lane, had no rally.
