Footnotes

WISE DAN targeted the leaders three wide in hand, moved up to join the vanguard midway through the second turn, kicked away nearing the furlong marker and widened under left handed urging. OPTIMIZER was unprepared at the start and off a step slow, moved up between horses for a contending position through the opening quarter, came to level terms on the second turn, continued on willingly but was no match for the winner. MIDDIE was unhurried into stride, was well back at the tail of the field, circled out of the second turn six wide and was along in time to earn the show. SILVER MAX opened clear to set the pace, was engaged after a half, relinquished the lead near the five-sixteenths pole, stayed on fairly well to the final furlong and faded. BIM BAM was within reach three wide, tucked in on the second turn, shifted back out entering the stretch, but weakened during the drive and faded. SLIM SHADEY (GB) was unruly in the gate, came away in good order, settled off of the inside to the second turn, angled out entering the stretch but went evenly. JERANIMO was allowed to settle off of the hedge, angled out leaving the second turn, drifted in through the drive but failed to improve position.
