STAKES Matt Winn S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$3,000 at the time of entry. \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 guaranteed. After payment of 1% of the monies to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I or II stakes at a mile or over, allowed 3 lbs.; \$60,000 at a mile or over, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Matt Winn will be limited to fourteen (14). If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box, the starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest career earnings. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee and supplementary nomination fee if applicable. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Saturday, June 3, 2017 with 21 nominations.

MCCRACKEN lost his footing at the start, was reserved and allowed to settle, made a bold four wide move after a half on his own courage, challenged midway through that turn, took over in midstretch, drifted to the inside and stayed clear under steady urging. COLONELSDARKTEMPER gained a forward position in the run to the first turn, angled out to the three path on the second turn, challenged between rivals on the second turn, could not keep pace with the winner in the stretch but held on gamely for the place. SOCIETY BEAU sluggish at the start, was outrun for a half, made a good three wide middle move, angled out for the drive but could not sustain the bid. MO'S MOJO closest to the pace while off the inside, challenged with three furlongs to go, held well to the final furlong and weakened. EXCITATIONS within striking distance along the inside, held on well for six furlongs and tired. AQUAMARINE sprinted clear, set the pace along the inside and gave way in the final quarter.
