KASAKUI (ARG) settled off of the inside, made a sweeping move four wide, struck the front nearing the furlong marker and shook clear. CHOCOLATE RIDE set the pace along the shrub, was unable to go on with the winner but dug in gamely to prove best of the rest. CONQUEST PANTHERA was unhurried into stride, settled off of the hedge, tipped out entering the stretch and kicked on well to earn the show. BONDURANT was close up three deep, moved up to engage the leader nearing the quarter pole, but weakened between runners and gave way. BLOFELD was unhurried, tucked in to save ground, swung to the outside in the upper stretch and finished with a belated improvement. PLEUVEN (FR) settled in hand three deep through the opening half, then between rivals, was bottled up in traffic inside the final furlong and failed to make headway. THATCHER STREET attended the pace along the hedge, got through but lacked a response when called upon. SECURITY RISK prompted the pace to the outside of CHOCOLATE RIDE through the first turn, settled just off of that one on the backstretch, but came up empty between horses after a mile and retreated.
