Footnotes

FOREVER UNBRIDLED settled saving ground through the opening half mile, worked her way off of the inside for clear sailing, ranged up four wide through the second turn with ease, came five wide into the lane, reeled in the stubborn APOLOGYNOTACCEPTED inside the furlong marker, shook off that one and edged clear. APOLOGYNOTACCEPTED was away in good order, angled in to dictate terms, repelled the challenge of BIG WORLD leaving the second turn, shook clear again and fought on through a long drive but was unable to go on with the winner. CARRUMBA attended the pace off of the inside, tipped off further entering the stretch, churned on but failed to make headway through the drive. BIG WORLD tracked three deep, moved up to engage APOLOGYNOTACCEPTED with five-sixteenths to run, but weakened slightly during the drive and gave way. TIGER MOTH was allowed to settle, moved up four wide to make a mild bid, angled in entering the stretch, but flattened in the final furlong. WEEP NO MORE was unhurried, dropped to the rail to save ground, got through into the stretch, shifted out a bit for the final furlong and finished with a mild improvement. WALKABOUT came away a beat slow, was unhurried along the inside and failed to threaten. ROMANTIC VISION settled toward the inside, but lacked a response when called upon.
