STAKES Kent S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each, which shall accompany the nomination; \$1,250 to enter and \$1,750 to start. \$200,000 Guaranteed, of which to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight; 122 lbs. Non-Winners of \$90,000 at a mile or over on the turf since May 15th, allowed 2 lbs.; \$60,000 at a mile or over on the turf since April 15th, 4 lbs.; \$40,000 at a mile or over in 2017, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered in estimating allowances.) Horses who finished first, second, third or fourth in the Stanton Stakes automatically earned a free nomination to the Kent Stakes. Trophy to the winning owner. Nominations closed Saturday, July 1, 2017 with 19 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management not to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Eighth).

Footnotes

FROSTMOURNE was allowed to settle off the early pace and began moving closer in the run to the far turn, gained the lead at the top of the stretch and was ridden out with good energy. MASTER PLAN moved closer with the winner on the far turn then finished well for second. ADONIS CREED hopped at the start then was allowed to settle, rallied into contention completing six furlongs and finished best of the others. LUNAIRE rallied leaving the far turn then lacked a further response. ZINGER never entered contention. THE TORTOISE quickly went to the front and set the pace through the far turn then had nothing left.
