CSABA raced up close to lead in opening quarter, settled back just off the pacesetter, asked to pick up pace nearing the far turn, angled out slightly, raced three wide at the top of lane, angled back in, vied along rail in late drive, dug in gamely and outfinished rivals at the wire. POOL PLAY was well reserved in early stages racing in back of the pack, continued patiently near the back heading into turn, angled out five wide at top of lane, rallied along outside, edged up to rivals before wire, dug in and just missed in final strides. PANTS ON FIRE stumbled at start, briefly lost momentum, recovered and stalked the early pace, made a bid and edged up to lead heading into far turn,raced three wide at top of the lane, vied into deep stretch with rivals, dug in gamely and just missed in final strides. SOLDAT settled along inside and stalked the early pace, began to advance position along outside going into far turn, edged up to lead at top of the lane four wide, vied with rivals into deep stretch, raced within contention and lacked final kick to prevail. GOOD MORNING DIVA edged up to lead shortly after start, challenged nearing the turn, vied between rivals along rail in deep stretch and could not keep up pace in late strides. SCATMAN tracked the top two leaders in early stages, asked to pick up pace heading into far turn, continued within contention in turn and began to weaken at top of the lane. ASSOCIATE away quickly from gate, vied with rivals for early lead along rail, settled back just bit off pace and began to falter going into far turn. DELEGATION urged up toward the lead in opening stages, settled back slightly and had nothing left after half mile.
