This race will not be divided. Preference will be based on current year earnings as recorded by Equibase at time of entry. Weights: Three Year Olds: 117 lbs. Older: 122 lbs. Field will be limited to 12 starters.

AWESOME SLATE stalked the early leaders while racing one out from the rail entering the backstretch, settled back of the leaders through the stretch the second time while racing two wide into the third turn, advanced smartly three wide midway down the backstretch the final time, rallied three wide approaching the final turn, took command soon after entering the turn, and held CRAZY PROPHET safely at bay late while being kept to task. CRAZY PROPHET unhurried early while dropping back to trail, continued to bide his time at the back of the pack through the third turn, rallied smartly four out from the rail entering the final turn, and closed determinedly four wide in the drive to prove clearly second best. VENETIAN MASK tracked the leader into the backstretch the first time while racing one out from the rail, maintained his position through the third turn and in the run down the backstretch the final time, engaged the pacesetter entering the final turn and took a narrow lead, but was quickly tackled by AWESOME SLATE, and while no match for that rival, battled gamely through the stretch to garner a share. NEVERADoubt settled off the early pace while racing three wide into the backstretch the first time, maintained his position through the third turn and down the backstretch the final time, launched his bid five wide entering the final turn, and finished willingly four wide in the drive. CALGARY CAPER settled off the early leaders while saving ground at the rail entering the backstretch the first time, maintained his position throughout in an even effort, while continuing to save ground. HIGHWAY BOSS tracked the leader into the backstretch the first time while racing one out from the rail, maintained his position into the backstretch the final time, rallied one out from the rail into the final turn, but failed to respond when called upon. HUNTERS APPEAL settled off the early pace while racing one out from the rail entering the backstretch the first time, held his position into the backstretch the final time, rallied three wide through the final turn, but lacked the needed closing response when called upon. KILLIN ME SMALLS raced to the lead entering the first turn while saving ground at the rail, controlled the pace through the third turn and in the run down the backstretch the final time, was collared entering the final turn, and weakened over the final furlong.
