Footnotes

WEST COAST fanned five wide into the first turn, stalked outside, came four wide into the stretch, rallied under urging to bid five wide a furlong out, gained the advantage, inched clear and was under a snug hold late. KLIMT prompted the pace outside a rival then between foes in upper stretch, fought back off the rail a furlong out, could not match the winner late but held second. B SQUARED four wide into the first turn, stalked off the rail, came four wide into the stretch, put a head in front between rivals at the eighth pole and was edged for second between horses late. COLONIST chased a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and just missed the show three deep on the line. CISTRON had good early speed and set a pressured pace just off the rail, fought back in upper stretch and weakened in the final furlong. KIMBEAR saved ground stalking the pace, continued inside in the stretch and also weakened in the final furlong. TERM OF ART settled off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and did not rally.
