### Footnotes

BENDABLE stalked off the rail then outside a rival into the turn, continued off the inside on the bend and three deep into the stretch, rallied under urging to gain the advantage three wide a sixteenth out and inched clear late. CONIAH bobbled in a slow start, saved ground off the pace, went up inside a rival leaving the turn and into the stretch, bid along the rail past midstretch, could not quite match the winner late but was clearly second best. PRETTY N COOL had speed between horses then pressed the pace outside a rival, took the lead past midway on the turn, inched clear while drifting out into the stretch, was between foes a sixteenth out and held third. BELLAMENTARY chased a bit off the rail then outside a rival leaving the turn, came out in upper stretch and lacked a rally. INVESTED PROSPECT bobbled at the start but quickly recovered and sped to the early lead, dueled inside, fought back leaving the turn, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and weakened.
