KANTHAKA settled off the rail then angled in leaving the backstretch, moved up inside then came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch, gained the advantage in upper stretch, kicked clear under urging, drifted in some and was under steady handling late. NERO prompted the pace three deep then stalked off the rail, re-bid three wide into the stretch, also drifted in some and was clearly second best. ALL OUT BLITZ chased off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch and edged rivals for third. AX MAN went up inside to duel for the lead, battled along the rail into and on the turn, put a head in front into the stretch then weakened through the drive and was edged late for the show. KRIS' ROCKET KAT settled off the inside, came a bit wide into the stretch and did not rally. MR. JAGERMEISTER had good early speed and dueled between horses then outside a rival, fought back leaving the turn, was between foes into the stretch and had little left in the final furlong.
