Footnotes

VYJACK disputed the pace from the outside, doing so from between rivals for most of the way around the turn, got released from a snug hold near the three-eighths pole, was set down spinning into the lane, battled on nearly terms with CLAWBACK making his way through the furlong grounds, held the slimmest of leads at the eighth pole, continued heads apart with the aforementioned opponent for another sixteenth, kicked clear, crossing the finish under hand urging. CLAWBACK secured a slim advantage soon after the start, showed the way from off the inside down the backstretch but was guided over to the rail at the half mile pole, argued to maintain command while being hounded by another pair, parked out in lanes two and three respectively, got called upon turning for home, having been unable to shake off either one, raced heads apart with the winner from the top of the lane until the sixteenth pole having relinquished the front in midstretch, dug in well to salvage place honors. RETREIVE took the three path around the turn, was the widest of a threesome fighting for the lead from about the half mile pole until midlane, finished willingly to the end but missed out on second. ORB raced four wide on the turn, was already under a strong drive entering the stretch, had no late response. LOGAN'S MOON got bumped at the start, was unhurried from off the inside until the head of the stretch, was taken hold prior to altering course outward three paths in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, mustered up a mild bid after completing the maneuver. ITHASTOBEGEORGE was bumped at the break, chased the ongoing pace dispute from the two path on the turn, got called upon at the five-sixteenths pole, failed to gain any ground. BAD HOMBRE got bumped from between just out of the gate, was in three path and under a full drive by the five-sixteenths marker, backed away. MR BEAUREGARD bumped at the start, saved ground and faltered. VALID underwent a four wide pursuit, folded. OUR KASHMIR bumped with LOGAN'S MOON leaving the starting gate and trailed throughout.
