### Footnotes

CALLED TO SERVE bumped with OUR ENTOURAGE just after the start, settled near the back of the pack along the outside, was unhurried while proceeding down the backstretch, entered the far turn three wide, but was in the four path after going slightly halfway around it, spun four wide into the stretch under strong urging, drove past WILLY BEAMIN to reach the eighth pole as the clear leader, kicked away from the others from that station onward, kept under a drive. WILLY BEAMIN grabbed the advantage a short distance out of the starting gate, showed the way initially two wide, but was sent closer to the rail about midway down the backstretch, was put to some light hand urging during the later stages of the run around the second bend, entered the stretch and was called upon for much more, yielded to the winner nonetheless, then dug in well enough long enough to salvage second. STEPHANOATSEE made light contact with the winner twice after a couple of jumps out of the starting apparatus, quickly tucked along the inside and rode the rail for just over six furlongs, was put to encouragement commencing to angle outward from the five-sixteenths pole until four wide by the head of the stretch, rallied with good energy but missed out on the place. ADIRONDACK KING secured the pocket shortly before reaching the end of the homestretch, patiently tracked the runner up, got asked for some run angling into the two path for the start of the stretch run, went on a little further then altered course in the direction of the middle of the strip for better racing clearance, was outfinished after ending all the maneuvering. GUILT TRIP was taken in hand firmly, mount pulling hard on the bit in reaction to it, as ADIRONDACK KING was sent over to the inside prior to arriving on the opening bend, swung outward thereafter, raced three wide on the second turn while forwardly placed, entered the stretch and soon backed away. OUR ENTOURAGE bumped just after departing the gate, assumed a forward position, stalked the pacesetter from the outside down the backstretch and around the far turn, under a firm hold initially, got turned loose for the stretch drive and tired.
