Footnotes

KINDERGARDEN KID settled into midpack, took the inside route during the initial stages, slipped to the two path after CAUSE OF FREEDOME ducked to the inside at the three-eighths pole, was given some rein and picked up interest late on the far turn, gained ground readily during the run through the furlong grounds, angled inward slightly and split rivals with about a sixteenth to, grabbed the lead prior to the wire and edged away. SAL THE BARBER under a firm hold sitting in the pocket, was taken outward coming to the five-sixteenths pole, was asked for some run issuing a three wide challenge as the field headed for the lane, forged to the front just as the three front runners reached the eighth pole, dug in with good determination to preserve the advantage, yielded reluctantly to the winner a few strides before reaching the finish line. RIGHT ONE (FR) well reserved along the outside for nearly three-quarters pole, took off with good energy after settling into upper stretch, was closing in fast on the top one's heels when angled outward in midstretch, continued on with good late foot to secure the show. TUNE ME IN away well, quickly established control, carved the pace, well rated from along the rail, came under heavy pressure from a pair of opponents nearing the quarter pole, and was let out in response, battled them for an additional furlong before backing away. LUBASH assumed the role of stalker, patiently prompted the pacesetter from the outside for the opening six furlongs, was let out a notch and bid between rivals from the quarter pole to the furlong marker, flattened out when unable to sustain the move. MINNIE PUNT bumped soundly with FLAMIN' HOT at the start, raced towards the rear of the pack, took the far turn from the three path, made a run from upper to midstretch before flattening out. CAUSE OF FREEDOME was guided over to the rail near the end of the backstretch, weakened. FLAMIN' HOT was pulled sharply off MINNIE PUNT but now before bumping hard with that one, failed to reach a contending position. NOLL WALLOP (IRE) a forward factor early, left the backstretch three wide, tired. MISSINGLISALEWIS eased back approaching the first turn, underwent a three to four wide journey nonetheless and folded.
