COMPLIANCE OFFICER sat patiently parked in the three path for nearly six furlongs, was asked for a response just before the field entered the stretch, overhauled the front runners during the upcoming furlong to take command, dug in with good determination to preserve the advantage, crossing the wire under a strong hand ride. LUBASH saved ground throughout, steadily advanced in the right direction during the run around the full turn, was moving well when forced to check hard approaching the quarter pole, having done so when in a bit tight off the pacesetter's heels at that juncture, was set down in short order with clear passageway for the taking, WRITINGONTHEWALL now having drifted out into the two path, drew abreast of the winner with an eighth to go, tried valiantly, but couldn't go by. STREET GAME three wide on the far turn, rallied for the show award. MINNIE PUNT underwent a three wide journey and mustered up a mild stretch response to earn the last major check. MR. VEGAS under a good hold from the rider, contently stalked the pacesetter from the outside, ranged up to issue a challenge late on the turn, got rebuffed and steadily weakened. POCKET COWBOYS off the inside throughout, swung four wide into upper stretch, lacked the needed response. ABILIO under a firm hold giving chase from the outside in midpack, came up empty for the stretch run. WRITINGONTHEWALL set the pace on an open lead from the rail, succumbed readily when challenged.
