**Footnotes**

MUNNINGS bobbled a bit at the start, moved up quickly along the inside, was under a firm hold while just behind the leaders for a half, waited patiently for room while behind horses in the two path on the turn, charged through between rivals to get clear at the three-sixteenths pole after EVERYDAY HEROES drifted out, quickly opened a clear advantage in midstretch then drew away with authority under a vigorous hand ride. EVERYDAY HEROES pressed the pace from outside for a half, battled heads apart in the two path entering the stretch, drifted out while dueling in upper stretch then continued to drift out under right hand urging while holding gamely for the place. KENSEI raced in the middle of the pack along the backstretch, steadied behind a wall of horses while blocked nearing the quarter pole, angled out for room in upper stretch then was carried out by the runner-up while gaining in deep stretch. HULL stalked the leaders three wide for five furlongs, remained a factor into upper stretch and lacked a strong closing response. THIS ONES FOR PHIL steadied along the inside at the half mile pole, lacked room while trapped inside MUNNINGS nearing the quarter pole then lacked the needed response when called upon after getting clear in upper stretch. GONE ASTRAY checked after breaking slowly, trailed for a half, swung seven wide at the top of the stretch and failed to mount a serious rally. HELLO BROADWAY was outrun for a half, made a run five wide to reach contention at the quarter pole and flattened out. TRIUMPHANT FLIGHT set a pressured pace along the rail into upper stretch and gave way.
