SEEKING DAYLIGHT was unhurried along the inside early on, advanced inside on the turn, swung wide into the stretch, responded when roused, drew away leaving the eighth pole and was wrapped up in the final yards, winning with something left. COUNTRY BE GOLD was outrun early, advanced inside on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and rallied to earn the place award. GRIFFINITE was outrun early, rallied four wide on the turn and finished well outside. E DUBAI pressed the pace from the outside, led between calls turning for home, could not handle the winner then tired in the final furlong. BOWMAN'S BAND was rated along early, rallied inside nearing the stretch, had a clear path on the rail and tired in the final furlong. FREE OF LOVE chased the pace while three wide and tired after the opening three quarters. DAYTON FLYER quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. INVISIBLE INK chased the pace from the outside and tired.
