Footnotes

WILLY BEAMIN lunged inward at the start, making light contact with GROUND FORCE but pulled away in time to prevent more damage, sat reserved near the back of the pack, rode the rail around the turn, paused prior to being angled three wide into the stretch, got straightened away and got called upon, poked a head down in front coming to the eighth pole, kicked clear, crossing the wire under a brisk hand ride. MANTECA took the inside route down the backstretch, got placed three wide for the run around the bend, ranged up towards the leader and issued a challenge coming to the quarter pole, had the winner make his presence in upper stretch with that rival being the first to reach the furlong marker, continued onward willingly to secure the place. PURE ATTITUDE was taken in hand and squeezed back at the break, raced along the outside, checked to steer well around the fallen rider in the vicinity of the three-eighths pole, remained well off the rail the remainder of the way on the turn, swung from the five path into the lane and came home with good courage to earn the show. MOONLIGHT SONG broke on top and was guided over towards the rail, had GROUND FORCE latch on soon afterwards and went head to head with that foe for most of the way down the backstretch, showed the way on the turn under no real pressure until nearing the quarter pole, got put to the test at that station and was set down, failed to keep pace with the first two finishers making his way from upper stretch to the eighth pole and steadily tired. MODERN CHILD underwent a four wide pursuit on the turn, folded. GROUND FORCE brushed with the winner at the start, moved up to contest the early pace, sparred on even terms from the outside with MOONLIGHT SONG, got shaken off nearing the end of the backstretch, stayed within range from the two path, got clipped from behind by BIGGER IS BETTOR at the midway point, tired after entering the stretch. CAP THE MOMENT off the inside, was checked while avoiding a fallen rider midpoint on the turn, then eased. GOOD KARMA saved ground, was checked while narrowing missing making contact

with BIGGER IS BETTOR and that rival's prostrate jockey at the three-eighths pole, then was eased. BIGGER IS BETTOR reserved in midpack in the two path, clipped the heels of GROUND FORCE midpoint on the turn, stumbling and losing the rider as a result, There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the incident on the turn before the result was declared official.
