SARATOGA SNACKS patiently prompted the pacesetter from the two path to the quarter pole, got asked for run after settling into upper stretch, took over the lead coming to the sixteenth pole and kicked clear. MINE OVER MATTER saved ground throughout, launched a bid from the head of the stretch, loomed boldly by the end of the furlong grounds, kept up the pursuit in a willing manner but had to settle for the place. B SHANNY away without incident at the break, quickly established control, tucked along the rail coming to the end of the backstretch, cut the pace well rated on a loosely-contested lead, came into the stretch and was asked for run, yielded a few strides past the eighth pole, weakened thereafter into the show slot. FIDDLERS AFLEET underwent a three wide pursuit on the turn and tired. BE BULLISH swung four wide into the stretch, had no rally. DAN'S GOLD in the three path midway on the turn, was outrun. WILLY BEAMIN lunged at the start, was along the inside and under a drive on the turn, made no headway.
