DOMINUS away in good order, quickly assumed control, set the fractions well rated from the inside, but with a couple of opponents in close attendance to his outside applying some pressure, continued along on the same scenario for the entire run around the turn, was let out entering the stretch, drew out to his advantage during the ensuing furlong, and held sway, being kept busy to the end. ADIOS CHARLIE was coaxed along prompting the top one from the outside, briefly lost contact after entering the stretch, regained some of that lost ground en route for the place. COOL BLUE RED HOT three wide entering the turn, got called upon after leaving it four wide, was outfinished. TECH FALL tracked the leader while taking the inside route, lacked the necessary stretch response. MALIBU GLOW raced along the outside and was no factor. HARLAN'S HELLO underwent a three wide pursuit, tired.
