Footnotes

KENSEI tucked in behind the early leaders while saving ground, settled in good position for a half, moved out to launch his bid leaving the far turn, split rivals to challenge at the five-sixteenths pole, took charge leaving the quarter pole, quickly opened a clear advantage in midstretch and edged away under intermittent right hand urging. CONVOCATION was taken in hand soon after the start, raced well back for a half, worked his way forward while moving out midway on the turn, swung five wide at the top of the stretch then closed late in the middle of the track to clearly best the others. WARRIOR'S REWARD stumbled badly at the start, raced far back for six furlongs, gained along the rail at the quarter pole, drifted out under left hand whipping in upper stretch and rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. AMERICAN DANCE pressed the pace three wide for a half, raced just outside the winner while beginning to drop back on the turn and steadily tired thereafter. MASALA chased four wide along the backstretch, angled in while within striking distance on the turn, advanced three wide into the stretch and steadily tired thereafter. JUST BEN rushed up to gain the early advantage, set the pace on the rail for six furlongs then gave way in upper stretch. SUNDAY SUNRISE was in hand early and failed to mount a serious rally.
