E DUBAI was sent directly to the front, controlled the pace while in hand, drew clear when set down turning for home, dug in gamely in the stretch and held off LIDO PALACE under a vigorous hand ride. LIDO PALACE (CHI) raced close up outside while in hand, advanced three wide on the second turn, responded when roused and finished gamely but could not get to the winner. MACHO UNO was rated outside, advanced outside on the second turn and finished gamely. EVENING ATTIRE was taken back after the start, was outrun early, advanced three wide on the second turn and offered a mild rally in the stretch. PURE PRIZE raced close up inside while in hand, saved ground and had no response when roused nearing the stretch. COUNTRY BE GOLD dropped back early and had no response when roused. PLEASANT BREEZE showed speed along the inside, was a bit rank under restraint, was sent up inside after E DUBAI on the backstretch, chased that rival for three quarters and tired.
