Non-winners of \$200,000 at a mile or over in 2013 allowed 2 lbs.; \$60,000 other than restricted stake at a mile or over, or three races, 5 lbs.; two races, 7 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter or restricted races not considered in allowances). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. MORENO broke out at the start bumping lightly with SAINT VIGEUR, established the front through comfortable fractions while three paths off the inside down the backside, picked up the pace into the turn gradually widening from the rest through to the quarter pole, got roused at that station, drew clear under a drive kept busy to the end to prevail. SAINT VIGEUR bumped lightly at the start when MORENO broke outwards, settled in hand just off the pace from the four path, came under coaxing at the half mile pole, improved mildly to the top of the stretch when set down in earnest, offered up a mild kick to hold for the place. FOR GREATER GLORY leapt up at the start conceding six lengths to the front, raced unhurried three wide towards the rear taking closer order on the field into the turn, remained patiently handled to the quarter pole in behind a wall of rivals, got roused three wide at that station as a seam opened inside SAINT VIGEUR, offered up a mild kick for the show. ABRAHAM four to five wide towards the rear of a compact field, came under prolonged urging at the seven-sixteenths, cornered four wide for home bidding mildly then weakened in the drive. MAKE YOUR MOVE saved ground throughout urged from the five-sixteenths and weakened in the stretch. BATTIER in reserve tracking three to four wide within close aim of the leader, came under a drive at the five-sixteenths, gave no offer and tired.
