ALBERT THE GREAT broke alertly, quickly showed in front, set the pace while removed from the inner railing, dug in gamely when set down for the drive, drew clear from MORE THAN READY inside the eighth pole, lugged in a bit in deep stretch and was driving under the wire. MORE THAN READY was bumped at the start, raced between rivals, put in a run along the inside in upper stretch and stayed on gamely to the finish. RED BULLET raced on the rail, had no response when roused and tired in the stretch. COMMENDABLE was bumped at the start, was steadied after the start, raced wide and tired in the stretch. A claim of foul lodged by the rider of the second place finisher against the first place finisher for alleged interference in deep stretch was dismissed.
