BROTHER IN ARMS off to an alert beginning, angled sharply towards the rail, set the pace along the rail, under the watchful eye of JOE VANN, continued along on the front during the run around the bend, with the rider keeping something in reserve all the while, came under attack from JOE VANN as that pair headed into lane, fought back tenaciously to protect the lead, having now been called upon, shook free nearing the eighth pole, then enough left to fend off the late-closing runner up. DOMINUS stumbled at the start, saved ground until the quarter pole, angled for the stretch run and came home with good energy down the middle of the strip to be well clear of the others for the place. JOE VANN mildly pressed the leader from the outside for nearly a half, moved up to issue a challenge for the lead nearing the quarter pole, dueled until midstretch and steadily weakened thereafter. KANAGARO raced along the outside and improved position by mainly weak and tired ones in the lane. BOMBAGUIA saved ground and was no factor. ADMISSION ducked to the inside coming to the half mile pole, too the inside route around the bend, angled three wide into the lane in preparation for the stretch drive, but failed to fire after being called upon. SAME OLD WISH chased the front runners travelling three wide, was put to encouragement on the turn but failed to keep pace.
